c. corresponding forms of present or imperfect :
εἶσι (v), "they are"

⑦ ἦεν

a. Parse + translate :

↳ 3rd p., singular, impf., active, indicative of ἄγω, I lead
↳ "he/she/it/singular they were leading"

b. change to opposite # :

ἦεν

c. corresponding forms of present or imperfect :
ἄγει

⑥ εἶ

a. Parse + translate :

↳ 2nd p., singular, indic., active, present of εἶμι, I am
↳ "you (sg.) are"

b. change to opposite # :

εἶστε

c. corresponding forms of present or imperfect :
ἦσαν

⑧ ἔλειπον

a. Parse + translate:

↳ 1st sg. OR 3rd pl. impf. act. indic. of λείπω, "I leave"

↳ "I was leaving" / "They were leaving"

b. change to opposite #:

ἐλείπομεν OR ἔλειπε(ν)

c. corresponding forms of present or imperfect:

λείπω, λείπουσι(ν)

⑨ ἔμενες

a. Parse + translate:

↳ 2nd p. sg., impf., active, indic., of μένω, "I remain"

↳ "you (sg.) were waiting"

b. change to opposite #:

ἐμένετε

c. corresponding forms of present or imperfect:

μένεις

⑩ ἔθέλεις

a. Parse + translate:

↳ 2nd p. sg. active indic. present of ἐθέλω, "I am willing"

↳ "you are willing"

b. change to opposite #:

ἐθέτετε

c. corresponding forms of present or imperfect:

ἤθελες
