 - g. change to opposite number: οἴσει

3. ἄξομαι
 - a. tense: future
 - b. person: 1st
 - c. number: singular
 - d. voice: middle
 - e. mood: indicative
 - f. principal parts: ἄγω, ἄξω
 - g. change to the opposite number: ἀξόμεθα

4. ληψόμεθα
 - a. tense: future
 - b. person: 1st
 - c. number: plural
 - d. voice: middle (deponent future)
 - e. mood: indicative
 - f. principal parts: λαμβάνω, λήψομαι
 - g. change to the opposite number: λήψομαι

5. οἴσειν
 - a. tense: future
 - b. person: n/a, infinitives have no person
 - c. number: n/a, infinitives have no number
 - d. voice: active
 - e. mood: infinitive
 - f. principal parts: φέρω, οἴσω
 - g. change to opposite number: n/a, infinitives have no number
